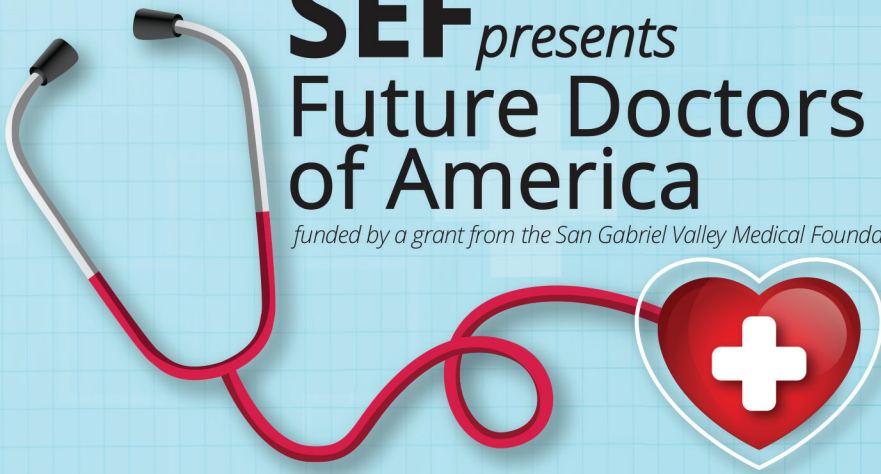

Class Offering

The Future Doctors of America program is a **FREE**, 10 session, after- school program designed to increase knowledge about heart health and disease prevention and to encourage a career in the medical field.

Students will learn how the heart works, how to listen to the heart with stethoscopes and how to take blood pressures. They will also learn about anatomy and diseases like diabetes and high blood pressure that affect the heart. In addition, they will learn about treating and preventing heart disease. The course is taught by Dr. Jonci Jensen a naturopathic doctor trained to use natural remedies and preventative care as well as the body's ability to heal itself.

The program seeks to increase knowledge about heart health and disease prevention and to encourage students to consider higher education and a career in medicine.
